

Study

The attitude towards study at Windsor Mountain is based on the belief that students should learn to plan their time so as to get their schoolwork done without being constantly pushed. A study period is held each afternoon from 4:30 to 6:00 and the boys and girls who are maintaining satisfactory levels of work may study in their rooms. If, on the other hand, the student's work is falling behind or if he or she has become a discipline problem, supervised study is prescribed by the teacher. Study halls are held in the library or in classrooms.

An evening supervised study hall is scheduled daily for those who need it. Students who can benefit from extra help are assigned to a three-hour study period held each Saturday afternoon.
