

The rest of the school buildings are at the bottom of the hill. Directly below the Main House is the *Boys' House*, a sprawling gray frame dormitory for the older boys (Grades 10, 11, and 12). A smaller frame building nearby, the *Classhouse*, contains sunny classrooms in a southern exposure. To the right is the *Laboratory Building*, which has completely equipped laboratories for chemistry and physics and for biology. Just north is the former *Garage*, another dormitory for the older boys, which also contains an auditorium with raised stage and a movie projection room. *The residence of the Heinz Bondys* is also in this area. The *Tea House*, a snack bar run by the students in the afternoons and evenings, is located near the Main House. There are faculty apartments in each dormitory so that adult supervision is provided at all times. All buildings are separately heated by oil.

The remainder of the campus is laid out in wide lawns shaded by stately pines, elms, and maples. Two outdoor stages are near the Main House while an outdoor basketball court and four playfields extend out from the Boys' House. There is also an outdoor picnic area with an open fireplace for barbeques. In the more heavily wooded areas behind Beaupre are numerous trails for hiking or cycling, both particularly popular Fall and Spring activities.
